Oh yeah...he comes from that first state on the list.

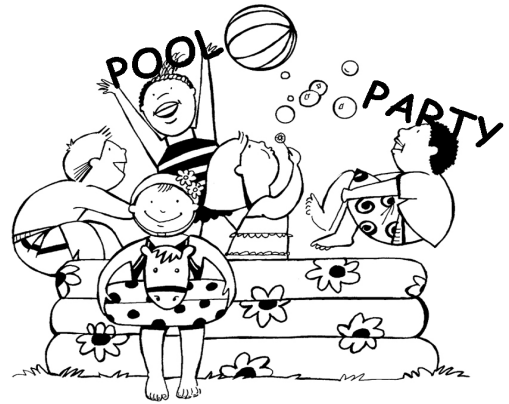

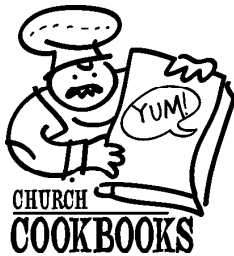
Addition to Graduates
